Racing will be held under the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the Open Meeting Sailing instructions of NCSC, the principals and practices of the RYA Racing Charter and the appropriate Graduate Dinghy Association class rules

Entry Fee for Helm and Crew £75.00 (entries received by 18th May)

£85.00 (entries after 18th May)

Entries will be allowed until 23rd May. Entries after 23rd May will be at the discretion of NCSC.

The entry fee includes evening meals for Helm and Crew on Saturday and Sunday. Additional meals must be pre-booked via the entry form at £10 per person per meal.

The 2018 Graduate Association AGM will be held at 17.00 hours on Sunday 27th May.

An event briefing will be held at 11.00 on Saturday 26th May in the area of the Race Office.

Race series planned;

The first start will be the Practice race NOT before 11.30 on Saturday 26th May.

Championship races 1 and 2 will follow. The start of race 1 not before 13.30.

Races 3, 4 and 5 will take place on Sunday. The first start not before 11.00.

Race 6 on Monday with the start not before 11.00.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
